Noteworthy Matters

- Prevailed in two-week jury trial on behalf of public pension in litigation confirming the termination of an investment property manager and recovering overcharged management fees.
- Prevailed in bench trial defending an executive of a Fortune 500 company against fraud and punitive damage claims in real estate litigation arising from an executive relocation.
